ADMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2019-20

Online application forms for admissions in different courses of the Nava Nalanda Mahavihara (Deemed University), Nalanda are invited upto June 15, 2019 for Indian and foreign students through website www.nnm.ac.in Nava Nalanda Mahavihara shall conduct **Proficiency (Written/Oral) Tests** for Indians and Foreigners for admission in the following Courses:-

Post Graduate/Under Graduate/Diploma and Certificate Programmes for the Academic Session 2019-20. Admissions will be made on the basis of merit in the Proficiency (Written/Oral) Tests, subject to fulfilling of eligibility requirements and availability of seats in the particular course for which the candidate has applied for and appeared in the **Proficiency (Written/Oral) Test**:

2.	B.A. in: Pali (Hons.)	6 Semesters/ 40 seats	A candidate shall be eligible for appearing in the Proficiency (Written) Tests leading to admission to B.A. (Hons.) in Pali. If he/she has passed the 10+2 or equivalent examination or Board, University and Institute of India and abroad.
3.	Diploma Course* in: (i) Pali (ii) Tibetan Studies	2 Years/ 40 seats in each subject	The admission for Diploma courses in Pali and Tibetan Studies, shall be open to a person who has passed Certificate Course in concerned subject from NNM or any recognized University/ Institution recognized by the NNM as equivalent thereto.
4.	P.G. Diploma* in: Chinese	2 Years / 40 seats	The admission for P.G. Diploma Course in Chinese shall be open to a person who has passed. 1 st year P.G. Certificate Course in Chinese.

5.	P.G. Certificate* Course in: Chinese	1 Year/ 40 seats	The admission for Certificate courses in Chinese shall be open to a person who has passed the 10+2+3 Degree Course or equivalent examination in any discipline with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate from any University/Institution in India or abroad recognized by the NNM as equivalent thereto.
6.	Certificate Course* in: (i) Pali (ii) Tibetan Studies	1 Year/ 40 seats in each subject	The admission for Certificate courses in Pali and Tibetan Studies shall be open to a person who has passed at least 10 th examination with 55% marks in aggregate of Board, University or Institution of India and abroad recognized by the NNM as equivalent thereto.

*** Note:** Certificate and Diploma Courses of the Mahavihara in Pali and Tibetan Studies can be pursued by a candidate independently before graduation or can concurrently while doing B.A., M.A. and Ph.D. However, graduate of any discipline can pursue P.G. Certificate Course in Chinese after they qualify oral proficiency test of the Mahavihara.

General Information:

1. The form completed in all respects may be submitted upto June 15, 2019 for Indian and foreign students, **Online** through, payment of Rs. 500/- by electronic mode.
2. Admit Cards may be downloaded **ONLINE** from the NNM Website from **20.06.2019 to 25.06.2019**
3. Foreign Nationals having foreign degrees are exempted from Proficiency (Written) Test. However, they would be required to appear for Oral Test which will be announced on website of Nava Nalanda Mahavihara, Nalanda.
4. Reservation of seats shall be as per UGC norms.
5. Date of Proficiency (Written) Test for admission in:
 - a) B.A. (Hons.) in Pali, M.A. in Pali, Sanskrit, English, Hindi and Tibetan Studies from **10.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. : 25.06.2019.**
 - b) M.A. in Philosophy from **2.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m.: 25.06.2019**
 - c) M.A. in Ancient History, Culture & Archaeology from **10.00 a.m. to 1.00 noon: 26.06.2019**
 - d) M.A. in Buddhist Studies from **2.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. : 26.06.2019**
 - e) Proficiency (oral) Test for Admission in Certificate and Diploma Course in Pail, Chinese and Tibetan Studies **03.07.2019.**
6. Declaration of Result : **05.07.2019**
7. Date of Admission : **08.07.2019 to 16.07.2019**
8. Classes begin from : **22.07.2019**

Note:

- i) Questions of the Proficiency Test for admission in M.A. Courses will be based on the Graduation level of the subject concerned.
- ii) Appearing candidates who are sitting for requisite qualifications for admissions in different courses may also apply but their admissions will be subject to declaration of their result within due date of admission.
- iii) Candidate may appear for admissions in more than one subject; his/her admission will be subject to his/her clearance of the test in the subject concerned.
